

VNA SELECTS NEW CEO

Steven A. Johnson has been selected Chief Executive Officer and President of the nonprofit Central Coast Visiting Nurse Association & Hospice, effective October 1, 2008.

Carol Snow, who became CEO-President in 2000, has announced her retirement.

Johnson most recently served as president of the nonprofit MedStar Health VNA, a \$3.2 billion healthcare organization of seven hospitals and healthcare services in the Baltimore-Washington region. As the area's largest health system, it is one of the largest employers with more than 23,000 employees and 4,600 affiliated physicians. MedStar Health *Visiting Nurse Association* is the largest home care division in the region and is nationally recognized for clinical quality and service excellence, providing skilled nursing, therapy, infusion and social work services. He also has been president of Johns Hopkins Home Care Group, vice president at UCSF Stanford Health Care, president of the four-hospital Legacy VNA in Portland and for 14 years he managed the 22-agency Upjohn Health Care Services in New York, Massachusetts, Rhode Island and Connecticut.
